WHO WE ARE

Maidstone Madrassah is dedicated to nurturing the spiritual and personal growth of our youth through a balanced education in Islamic teachings and values.

We provide a welcoming environment where students can learn, develop character, and become compassionate, responsible members of society.

Our system encourages critical thinking and an innovative spirit.





CLASSES

ELEMENTARY CLASSES (AGES ~ 5-7)

This course equips the student with the foundations and fundamentals for understanding and following Islam. It includes reading of the arabic alphabet and harakat through the Noorani Qaida, Duas and Salah, and More.

INTERMEDIATE CLASSES (~ 8-11)

This course builds on foundational knowledge to deepen students' understanding of Islam. They will explore tajweed through Juzz'Amma, various surahs, and engage with important Hadiths, Dua's, and supplications.

ADVANCED CLASSES (~12-15)

This course provides students with a comprehensive study of Islam, including the Seerah of the Prophet and Islamic Jurisprudence. It also covers contemporary issues, Quran memorization with Tajweed, and Islamic History.

ELDER TEENS (16+) (SAT ONLY)

This is for the elder teenagers who have either graduated from the madrassah or read at a proficieint level to keep their reading sharp and learn more advanced topics such as figh.



FEE STRUCTURE

We have simplified our fee structure to make it easier for parents while ensuring the highest quality of education for your children.

GENERAL TUITION FEES:

- Our rate is £2.25 per hour.
- Fees are charged as 10 equal monthly payments of £48.60 from September to June. There is nothing to pay in July.
- This covers the full academic year of 36 teaching weekends (72 sessions).
- An invoice will be generated on the 1st of each month, payable within two weeks.
- A Direct Debit mandate is required upon registration to secure your child's place.
- A £1 non-refundable fee is payable upon registration.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS:

- 20% discount for the 2nd child.
- 50% discount for the 3rd child.
- 4th child and onwards are fully exempt from tuition fees.

ONE-TIME PRODUCT FEES

(Non-Discountable):

- Study Pack: A one-time fee of £30 is required for all new students upon registration.
- Book Fees: A separate fee is required when a student moves up to a new level. These fees are based on the materials required, and prices are available on the MIC website.
- Please note: Product fees (Study Pack and Books) are not included in sibling discounts and are payable by all families, including those exempt from tuition fees.

ADVANTAGES OF IN PERSON MADRASSAH VS ONLINE

Personalised Attention and Immediate Feedback

In an in-person madrassah, students benefit from direct interaction with teachers, who can observe their progress and immediately correct any mistakes. This allows for tailored instruction that addresses each student's specific needs. Whether it's reciting the Qur'an, learning tajweed, or understanding Islamic rulings, having a teacher physically present ensures students can clarify doubts and receive focused guidance.

In-person classes enable students to form strong social bonds with their peers, fostering a sense of community. Learning together allows students to share knowledge, support each other, and work collaboratively. This was of education instills Islamic values like cooperation, patience, and mutual respect, which are harder to cultivate in an online setting.

Barakah of Praying Together in Congregation

Attending an in-person madrassah provides the opportunity to participate in congregational prayers, which carries immense barakah (blessings). Praying together strengthens the bond of brotherhood and sisterhood among students, and the rewards of collective worship far exceed those of praying alone. It also helps students develop a habit of attending the masjid or madrassah regularly for salah, instilling a sense of community and unity.



Enhanced Focus and Discipline

The physical setting of a madrassah minimises distractions common in an online environment. With a structured classroom, students are more likely to remain focused on their studies. The disciplined atmosphere helps maintain attention and promotes an effective learning routine, allowing for better retention and understanding of Islamic knowledge.

Curriculum

The aim of the curriculum is to deliver Islamic teaching in a dynamic, interactive and fun environment.

The aim of the Madrasah is to ensure each child is able to at least complete the Quran with proficiency within 4 years of education, Memorise Dua's and half of Juz-Amma as well as primary teachings of Islam.

Once the child has been assessed, they will be placed in one of the 3 classes based on their ability: Elementary, Intermediate or Advanced.



Reports

There will be an opportunity to discuss your child's progress via 1 to 1 meetings with the teachers at the end of each term.

We aim to deliver an end of term report for each child to highlight the following areas:

- Progress in Qaida/Quran recitation
- Memorisation of Dua's & Surahs
- Grasp of topics of Islamic Studies
 - Attendance and time keeping
 - Behaviour



Teachers

Our teachers are carefully recruited based on their competence and enthusiasm. All teachers undergo an interview process before selection.

Our teachers are supported by our Imam, Dr S Usmani.
